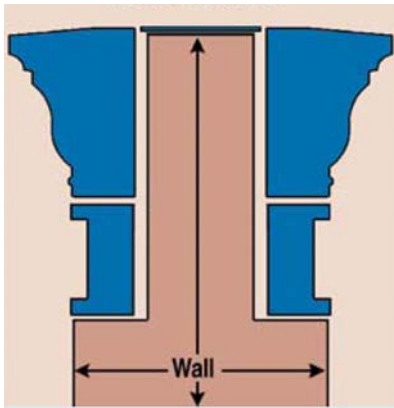


Design Options - Caps for Landscape Walls

Surround your home with the luxurious beauty of landscape walls with cast stone wall caps

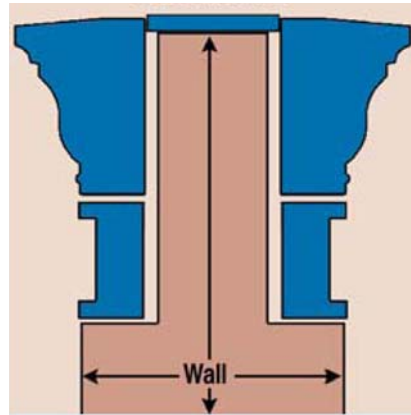
There are 4 types of examples for top closures with the banded pier/wall caps

Mortar Filled



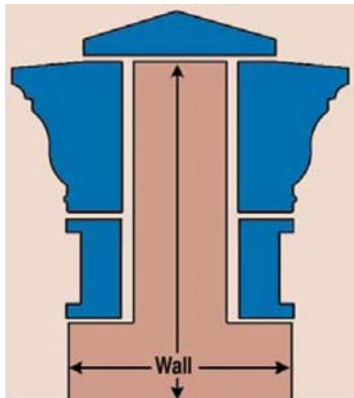
Mortar filled is great for a taller wall, where the top is never visible.

Flat Closure



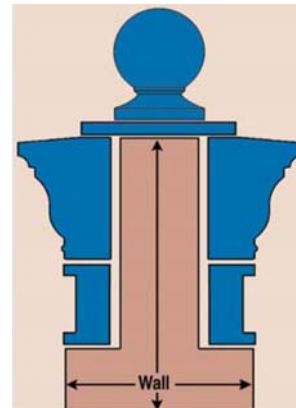
A flat stone or one with a slight slope works well for the flat closure.

Solid Cap



A solid cap makes everything look finished.

Finial

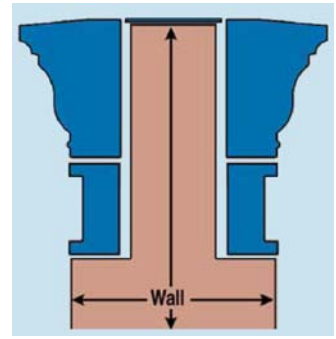


Finials bring an added touch to banded pier caps.

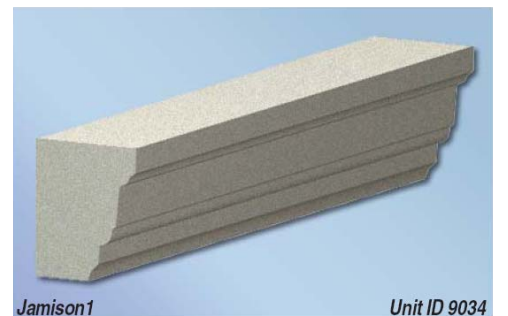
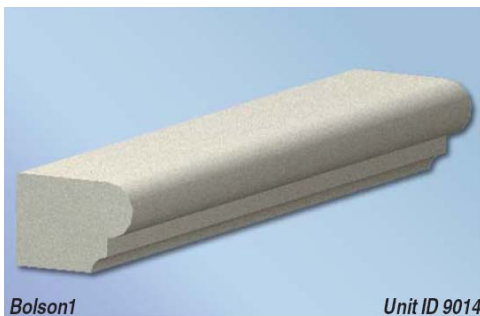


Here are several examples of our Half Cap Wall Caps

Slight Slope

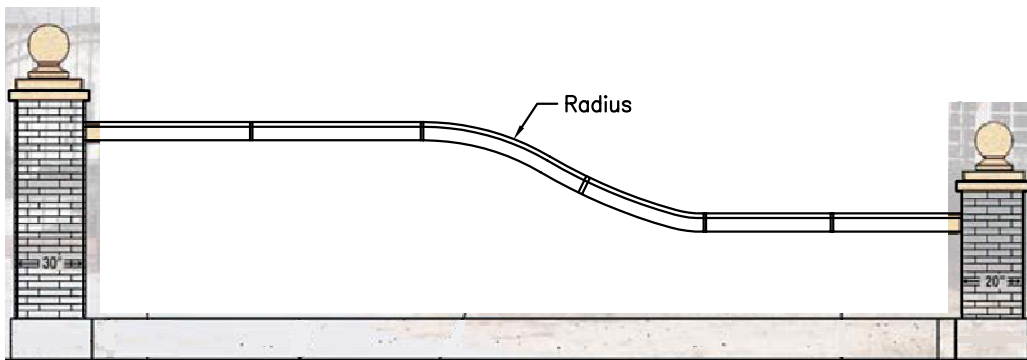
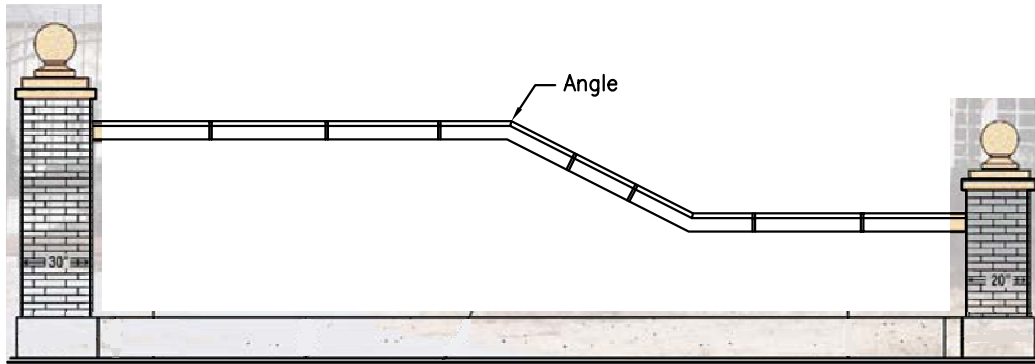


Flat Top

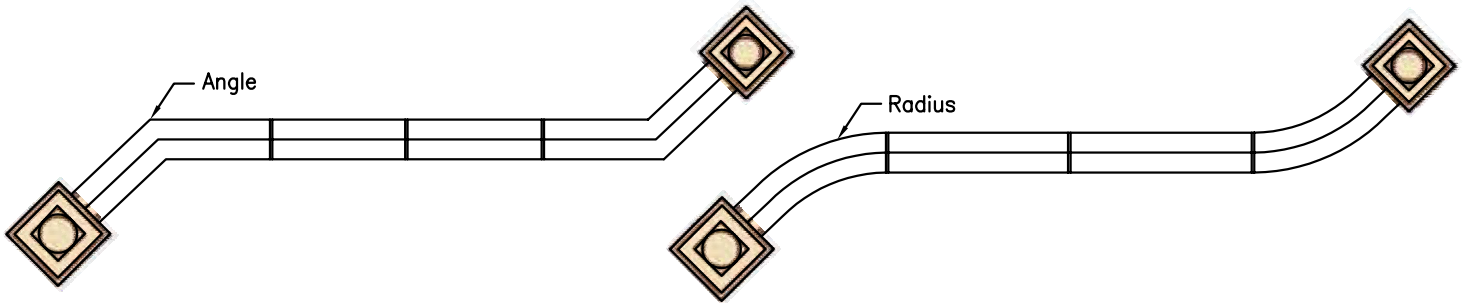
