What is the scope of the project?

Produced were the following Cast Stone elements - a variety of window surrounds and sills for the exterior, bracketed banding at the roofline, columns and balustrade along back patio, and the front entryway, including steps, balustrade, columns, first and second floor surrounds, and pediment. In addition, the columns, balustrade, and banding for the interior pool area are cast stone.

What is the role of Cast Stone?

The Cast Stone is the accent material for the entire exterior of the home. The Cast Stone stands out from the colored stucco and surrounds each architectural feature of the façade.
