

## Window Surrounds Assembly Illustrations



A Setting Line (SL) is used to identify a specific line from


which to install the parts. Profiles can be set aligned with

the setting line, or offset from the line. Depending on the

installation of the Parts, the Setting Line can be based on

several controlling factors, for example: face of wall, drips,

This window surround is made from the parts encircling it, which are in turn made from the three profiles, Chamfer, Jamison, and Bolson.



These profiles shown to the left show a profile family, which is a group of different profiles that go together. The Jamison-Bolson-Chamfer family is one of our most popular combinations for surrounds.



Jack Arches are another design option. They are partial surrounds that accent only the top of the window or door. They are made up of the same basic parts and similar profiles as standard surrounds.
