

Many of the flat entries are great as an interior door units too, single- or double-faced!

Entry Unit Styles

Stone Legends currently offers a wide variety of Entries, in many styles from classical shapes to a more ornate, baroque appearance. A few have optional sizes available and some can be modified in height and/or width to fit your project.

Shown on this chapter are only a few of those currently available, many with actual photos of installed units. The drawings are not to a specific scale.

For ease of use, we have categorized our entries into four styles:

Flat Entry

Entries attached directly to your structure, with minimal projection. They may or may not include door jambs or soffit returns.



Flat Entry

Recess or Alcove Entry

Entries that stand out from the face of the building, some by as much as 3 feet or more, but are not classified as porticos.

Porch / Portico Entry


Entries that stand out from the face of the



building, supporting roofs or balconies.

Full Facade Entry

Entries using stone facing for all or most of the front wall surface area. Since these are highly



technical, we recommend contacting us as early in the building design process as possible.
