
Dear Richard:



Enclosed please find a roll of film I shot of my Stone Magic fireplace here in Michigan. I'm never certain when using a flash so I hope the pictures are there. You might be interested to know that I washed the stone with a yellow milk paint and then wiped it with a solution of white. I was looking for the effect of "old French limestone". The fireplace lights up the room even when there's no fire burning. I think it took my mason less than an hour to install which was a lovely surprise, and virtually no mess but we did have to find a few strong boys to help lift the pieces in place. In all I'm delighted with the finished product which is definitely the focal point of my library/ living room.
