

Raleigh Dart Fountain Side Section



The CPP's (Customer Plan Pages) should look a bit familiar to you. They are based on plans, photos or sketches that you have supplied to Stone Legends.

Each CPP, as seen in the CPP, Fig. 1, will be marked with a CPP Number that relates directly to the original drawings supplied by you.

You will see various types of Symbols and Notations as you review the CPP's. Refer to the following pages for more information.



What is a Product Group?


By using Product Groups, Stone Legends can breakdown the bid into Areas.


A Column can be bid under a Product Group for Columns, but it could also be bid under the Product Group for Entries.


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


SYMBOL DEFINITIONS

CPP STAMP

The CPP (Customer Plan Page) Stamp refers to the plans that you sent to Stone Legends.

Whether an overview plan or an enlarged plan, the CPP Number will be the same as the drawing number from your plans. The Project ID is our numerical count of your project.



AREA STAMP

The Area Stamp is used to identify Product Group Areas within a Customer Plan Page. This allows visual verification of estimated Units and Quantities.

The Area Stamp maps out a path between the Customer Plan Pages and the Estimated Bid for you to follow.

- Area Abbreviation The identifier for a grouping of similar products. Refer to the Area Abbreviation Legend: refer to page CPP Help-6.
- Checker Number To be added later, the Checker Number is a consecutive count and numbering of the Units within a specified Area.

Organizing Units by Product Groups that are similar and by a Checker Number allows communication of intent by verifying Unit Counts. Example: 57 Units would be labeled sequentially in 57 separate boxes as 1-57.

- UID Unit Identification A unique ID of an existing Unit that has already been cataloged. For Internal Company Use.
- Unit Mark May or May not be used in the Estimated Bid Phase, the Unit Mark adds an Alphabetic Unit Mark to each Unit.



What is Area?

Area is a grouping of similar products on your Customer Plan Pages.

> Is that similar to Product Group?

Yes, the Product Group on the Estimated Bid reflects directly to the Area highlighted on the Customer Plan Pages.

NOTE STAMP


The Note Stamp is used to clarify product locations and to convey concerns or options related to the Customer Plan Pages and the Estimated Bid.

The Note Stamp is a prime point of communication between the estimator and the client.

ENLARGED VIEW BUBBLE

This is used when a small Area of your Customer Plan Page requires enlargement in order to clarify the information relating to an Area or Unit.

Expect to see enlarged CPP's within the pages following.



SECTION CUT

The Section Gut indicates the necessity to show a detailed cutaway or section of a particular Unit based on your Gustomer Plan Pages. This allows showing the inner workings of the Unit and how different Profiles interface with each other.
